Youth Suicide Prevention & Awareness Organization Commemorates History of
"Keeping More Than Dreams Alive"

(Hendersonville, TN – September 30, 2015) On October 1st, The Jason Foundation (JFI) is celebrating their 18th Anniversary. JFI was founded in Hendersonville in 1997 after the tragic death of Jason Flatt, the 16-year-old son of Clark Flatt. Over the past 18 years, JFI has grown to be a national leader in youth suicide prevention and awareness. The Jason Foundation programs are currently being utilized in all 50 states, American territories, and several foreign countries. All programs are offered at no cost to participants with whom we contract.

Clark Flatt, President of The Jason Foundation, said, "Hendersonville, and the Sumner County area, has been our corporate home since day one. We are very appreciative of the community that has been instrumental in what we have been building."

Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for middle and high school age youth, as well as college age youth. It is also one of the leading causes of PREVENTABLE death.

The Jason Foundation believes that awareness and education are the keys to Prevention. Four out of five teens who attempt suicide have given clear warning signs. By knowing the warning signs, and knowing how to help, you could save a life.
