This dedication has enabled JFI to reach millions of people and has established the foundation as a nationally recognized leader in suicide awareness and prevention.

Over the years, The Jason Foundation has expanded to include 188 Affiliate Offices across 33 states, providing programs and services throughout all 50 states. Each office is united in the mission to enhance awareness and prevent youth and young adult suicide. This mission, however, cannot be fulfilled in isolation. While donations play a crucial role in sustaining these efforts, it is the collective action of individuals who educate themselves, inspire others to learn, and advocate for awareness within their communities that truly makes a difference.
